




Here is a list of all the important things to know for the September 2021 Remote Proctoring Exams.

Genuine Operating System

Your system must be powered by one of the following licensed operating systems:

Windows 10 (64-bit) – (excluding 'S Mode') or

Mac OS High Sierra (10.13) and above –

(excluding beta versions). If it does not pass the validation scan, you will not be able to take the exam.



Internet Connection

You may use a dongle but not a mobile hotspot. A wired network is preferred over wireless, for more details <u>click here.</u>

Everything you're allowed to keep on your desk on exam day, <u>detailed.</u>




The digital scratchpad
